- Help make & pack school lunches
- Help with meal prep (chop, measure, pour etc.)
- Water plants
- Get trash from rooms

8-9 Years Old

ALL Prior Chores AND

- Clean bathroom toilets, sinks & counters
- Wipe kitchen table, counters, appliances, cupboards & sink
- Wash dishes
- Help with yard work
- Walk pets & clean cages
- Clean mirrors
- Help in more advanced meal prep
- Make/pack school lunches
- Load dishwasher
- Change own sheets

10-11 Years Old

All Prior Chores AND

- Garbage/recycling to curb (& back in again)
- Mop
- Clean Kitchen
- Yard work
- Do laundry

12 Years Old +

All Prior Chores AND

- Clean shower/tubs
- Mow the lawn
- Iron clothes
- Clean the garage
- Clean windows

NOTE: These are guidelines. Some kids will be ready to do more sooner & others will need more time for some tasks.

DAILY / WEEKLY / MONTHLY CLEANING SCHEDULE

DAILY

Kitchen

- 1) Load/run/empty dishwasher as needed
- 2) Wash dishes in the sink

- 5) Sweep/vacuum

Bedrooms

- 1) Make beds
- 2) Clothes in hampers
- 3) Toys away

Bathrooms

- 1) Clothes picked up
- 2) Towels hung up
- 3) Toothbrushes & toothpaste away
- 4) Products & beauty appliances away

General

- 1) One load of laundry
- 2) 2 minute tasks
- 3) 10 minute evening tidy
- 4) Sweep/vacuum main floor

WEEKLY

Kitchen

- 1) Disinfect counters & sink
- 2) Disinfect backsplash
- 3) Wipe down fronts of appliances & cupboards
- 4) Dust or vacuum baseboards & vents
- 5) Dust lighting & photos/art
- 6) Check fridge for expired food and quick wipe of inside
- 7) Vacuum & mop floors

Bathrooms

- 1) Clean toilets
- 2) Clean tubs & showers
- 3) Clean sinks
- 4) Clean mirrors
- 5) Dust lighting & photos/art
- 6) Dust or vacuum baseboards & vents
- 7) Change garbage
- 8) Vacuum and mop floors

All Other Rooms

- 1) Dust/tidy shelves, furniture, lighting & photos/art
- 2) Vacuum furniture/under cushions
- 3) Dust or vacuum baseboards & vents
- 4) Clean mirrors
- 5) Clean windows with handprints
- 6) Vacuum/mop stairs & floors

WEEKLY

Paper

- 1) Pay bills, respond to any mail/paper from the week
- 2) File papers need to keep
- 3) Discard papers no longer needed
- 4) Review appointments & commitments for week ahead.

MONTHLY

WEEK 1:

- 1) Disinfect trash cans
- 2) Disinfect door handles, light switches & doors (if needed)

WEEK 2:

- 3) Run washing machine & dishwasher clean cycles
- 4) Clean windows as needed

WEEK 3:

- 6) Dust blinds (if applicable)
- 7) Wash comforters

WEEK 4:

- 5) Thorough clean of inside of fridge & oven

TIPS

- 1) **Assign tasks to days:** Mon = Kitchen, Tues = Bedrooms etc.
- 2) **If a task takes less than 2 minutes, do it now.** This instantly reduces clutter which makes cleaning faster.
- 3) **10-Minute Tidy:** No one always follows the 2-minute rule, so take 10 minutes at the end of each day to return items to their proper homes.
- 4) **Pick Up :** Before cleaning any room, pick up all items not in their homes.
- 5) **Clean from top to bottom:** Start on ceiling fans & high shelves & work down to vents & baseboards. Vacuuming & mopping should be last.

LAUNDRY

DAILY: start a load of laundry when you begin cleaning & complete other daily cleaning tasks while it washes/dries
